A sparked-up Arapahoe team defeated the Franklin Flyers to revenge the 40-0 defeat the Indians suffered last year. Highland scored both touchdowns, which led the Indians to a 14-12 victory.

The Indians were miserably defeated on a muddy field by the Trenton Warriors. The final score was 25-6. The second team, led by Larry Dyer, was the only team able to hit paydirt. Bob Morse made the only touchdown of the evening for the Indians.
