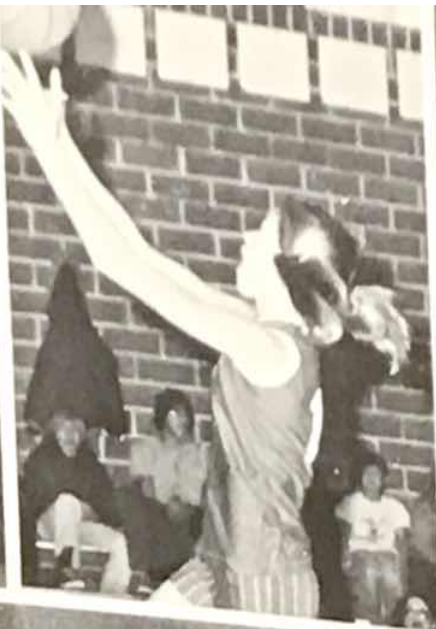
The chapter donated money towards the sound system, held a breakfast before school and Christmas caroled throughout the town and the rest home.
