Many other students from A.H.S. participated in the Inter High Day, and gained experience, and will hopefully be winners next year.

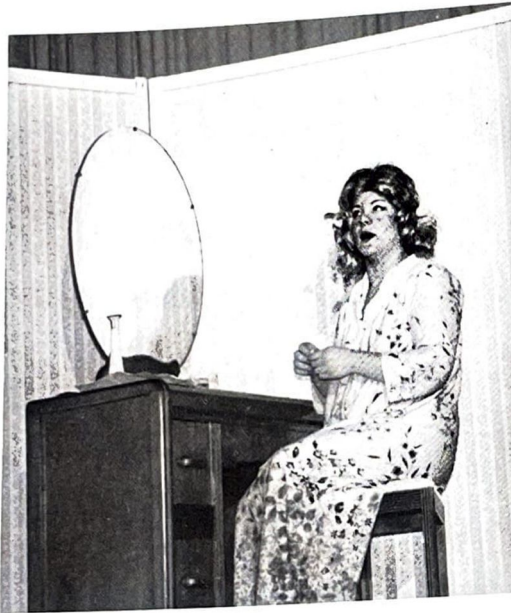

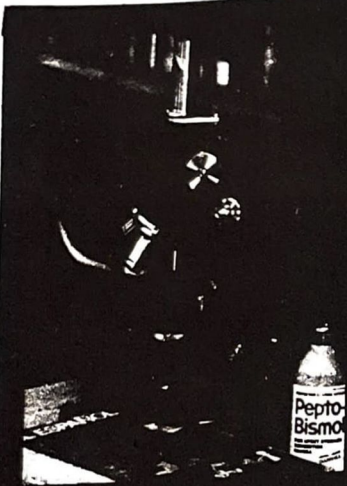
