

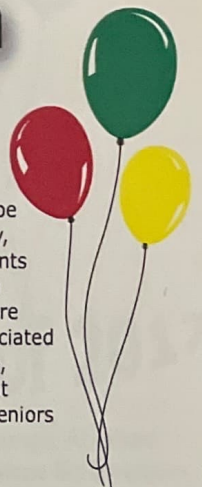
Flying High

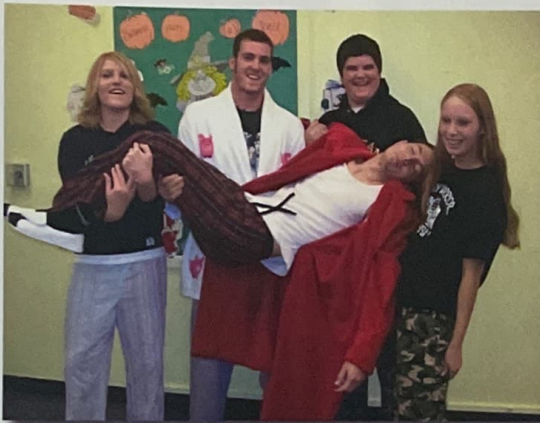

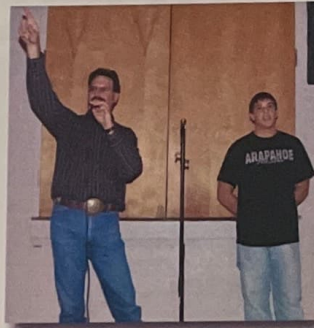

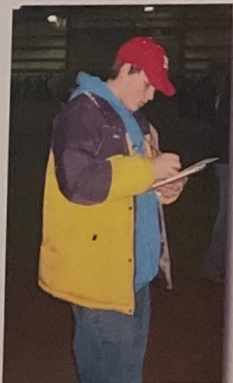
